



2022 show - addendum to standard booking terms and conditions for overseas exhibitors

Due to the current Covid-19 situation, the following cancellation and withdrawal regulations apply:

Cancellation without Statement of Reason

The prevailing cancellation terms & conditions as stated in the Exhibition space contract apply.

Travel Restrictions Applicable to Exhibitor

The exhibitor has the option to submit a written request to the organizer of the exhibition asking to transfer its stand booking status and deposits paid to the next edition of the exhibition and the organizer should give written confirmation to such request within 7 business days from the date of receipt of the written request. Any transfer will be considered if the following conditions be met or enforced upon the attendees of the exhibitor.

- The written request is received by the organizer no later than 4 weeks before the opening show day of the exhibition.
- The individual booth representatives of the exhibiting company are required to quarantine on arrival in Singapore for more than 5 days during the week lead up to the exhibition dates.
- The individual booth representatives of the exhibiting company are required to quarantine for more than 7 days on their return to their home country for the week preceding the last day of the exhibition.

The home country is defined as the country the representative is resident in.

Evidence will include but without limitation to the published information from the Singapore government or the state authorities and the government of the home country or its state authorities of the attendees of the exhibitor confirming the need for quarantine upon arrival to Singapore and from return to their home country from Singapore.
